Dr. Marcello Tonelli is Senior Associate Dean (Clinical Research) at the Cumming School of Medicine and Associate Vice President (Health Research) at the University of Calgary. He received an MD from the University of Western Ontario, an SM in epidemiology from Harvard University, and an MSc in health policy from Imperial College London. He is a nephrologist and Professor at the University of Calgary.



Dr. Tonelli is the past President of the Canadian Society of Nephrology, a past Councillor of the International Society of Nephrology, and a past member of the Kidney Disease: Improving Global Outcomes (KDIGO) board of directors. Dr. Tonelli is chair emeritus of the Canadian Task Force for Preventive Health Care, a national panel of experts that makes recommendations about preventive health services to Canada's 36,000 family physicians.

A unique aspect of Dr. Tonelli's research program includes partnering with regional, provincial, and national decision-makers to ensure that the findings will be used to produce rational health policy.
